Classes Offered

NURSERY 30 min. / week (3 years)

Combines creative movement and story line based activities with music to help develop the co-ordination necessary for starting dance classes at 4 years old.

PRESCHOOL 45 min. / week (4 years)

Introductory level that is based on ballet technique with a jazz flare to music they can relate to.

PRE PRIMARY 45 min. / week (5 years)

Increased level of ballet & jazz technique to music they can relate to.

TAP 45 min. - 1 hour / week (5+ years)

The feet form sounds and patterns to achieve rhythm, timing and co-ordination. Your feet will make the music.

JAZZ 45 min. - 1¼ hours / week (6+ years)

A fast moving, high-energy class that focuses on developing technique, flexibility and different styles. Ballet classes are highly recommended to enhance their jazz ability.

BALLET 45 min. - 1½ hours / week (6+ years)

Classical technique in Cecchetti develops discipline, alignment, correct muscle use and strength to enhance poise and grace that each dancer requires.

JAZZ and BALLET TECHNIQUE 1¼ - 1½ hour / week (11+ years)

A non-syllabus class focusing on the basic steps and physical training of the particular discipline. This class will achieve higher results advancing the students overall training. Not a performing class.

LYRICAL 1 – 1¼ hour / week (12+ years)

A continuous, gentle, flowing form of jazz and ballet technique with an emphasis on expressing the music. Students must be enrolled in the competition ballet and jazz program.

MODERN 1 - 1¼ hour / week (12+ years)

A new dance technique based on the principles of core strength and floor work. Students must be enrolled in a Cecc Ballet class.

PRE POINTE' and POINTE'— 45 min. / week (12+ years)

Students with a strong technical foundation will be slowly introduced to Pointe work. Students accepted into Pointe' will need teacher's direction on fitting pointe shoes.

MUSICAL THEATRE 1 hour / week (7-9 years)

Develops the acting, singing and dancing component of performing that produce entertaining routines. A student must also be enrolled in a jazz, tap or ballet class in order to take this class.

HIP HOP 1 hour / week (9+ years)

Learn the latest hip hop steps from R&B, Pop, and Rap videos. There are two levels, Recreational & Competition, those who are in 'C' levels must be approved by the teacher and have past experience.

ADULT 1 hour / week (20+ years) **FULL YEAR PROGRAM**

Choice of jazz, tap or hip hop classes. Beginner & Experienced classes offered depending on registrations. Option to perform must be made prior to Nov. 1st.

Separate registration required & will perform in Stars of Hope, Festivals and Recital.

ENROLLMENT

- All registration is done online at www.DarlenesDance.com
- Print and fill out Payment Registration Form.
- Mail or submit forms and payment to office within 5 business days.
- Payment is Registration Fee, First and Last month's tuition that is non-refundable unless we are unable to place the student.

TUITION and PAST DUE

- Tuition is based on a yearly fee divided by 10 months for customer convenience. It bears no relationship to the number of classes in any given month especially for the month of June. Tuitions are also not pro-rated for any late enrollments. See Yearly Tuition Rates.
- Any chqs returned NSF, etc. are subject to a \$25.00 charge on your account.
- Monthly tuition payments along with other fees such as Festivals and Costumes are due on the 1st month with a grace period until the 7th of the month. Fees paid after the 7th of the month will be considered past due and a \$15.00 late fee will be automatically added to the students account.

PAYMENTS (Exact details on our Registration Payment Form)

- 1) **AUTOMATIC CREDIT CARD PLAN** (Visa or Master Card)
 - We automatically bill your credit card on the 1st of the month leaving you with no late penalties. The Exemption Rule applies to this plan.
- 2) **MONTHLY POST DATED CHEQUE PLAN**
 - Must provide a credit card on file to secure your account.
 - The Exemption Rule will apply to this plan.
- 3) **PAY MONTHLY PLAN**
 - No credit card is left on file to secure your account.
 - All payments must be made by the 1st of the month.
 - The Exemption Rule will *not* apply to this plan.

EXEMPTION RULE

For customer convenience, customers whose monthly tuition is \$165/month and over to pay June's tuition fees in June instead of at registration time. This rule will not apply for Plan #3.

UNLIMITED TUITION

When a student or family reach a total amount of class hours per week, the tuition is then capped and considered "Unlimited".

- **Cap 1 Student-** Unlimited after **8 hours** of classes a week.
 - **Cap 2 Students-** Unlimited after **10 hours** of classes per week.
 - **Cap 3 Students-** Unlimited after **12 hours** of classes per week.
- Registering online will not show correct pricing and the office will need to manually adjust the account to reflect the capped price.

COSTUME DEPOSIT

Charge of \$40.00 per class is due on Dec. 1st with the balance due by Feb. 1st and is subject to late fees if not paid on time. Classes not subject to this fee are: Jazz or Ballet Technique, Pre Pointe or Pointe, Cecc Int. and Adult classes.

OTHER COSTS

Festival Entry Fees – All classes marked with a 'C' Level are automatically entered into 2-3 Festivals. 'R' levels are subject to teacher's approval for possibly 1 Festival. Billings and payments are due on Nov. 1st and will be subject to late fees if not paid on time.

Year End Recital – Ticket Admission and Costume is required. The same costume is used for Festivals and Recital.

WITHDRAWALS

Students are enrolled in classes for the year. If dropping any class/es, a 'Drop Class Request' slip must be filled out and submitted into the office before the 1st of the month in order to adjust your account prior to the next month. Registration, First and Last month's tuition is non-refundable .
